Then, Best of Show was presented to Steve Moorman and his classic 1924 Rolls Royce Springfield Silver Ghost Pall Mall Tourer. Assembled with parts from England, American vendors were added for accessories and electrical systems. Updated features and mechanical refinements were first applied to Derby-built Rolls Royces and then added to Springfield cars. These included American-made Bosch magnetos and coil ignition, Bijur generators and starters and American-made wire wheels. Steve Moorman's Rolls is number 179 of the Pall Mall Tourers built on a Springfield chassis. Steve says that he has been working for two years on its restoration and still has more to do; it is truly a spectacular automobile. Congratulations to Steve Moorman and his wife Bridget on his Best of Show Award! And congratulations to all of our winners. Your cars are all special!
